

VENDOR RULES AND CONDUCT

All vendors and vendor merchandise is subject to review and approval by Historic Downtown Sikeston. Historic Downtown Sikeston(HDS) reserves the right to refuse any vendor application.

All vendors must be approved by HDS and sign the Vendor Rules and Conduct sheet.

Any vendor who displays objectionable merchandise or conducts themselves in a vulgar or rude manner will be removed from the market.

The following products are NOT allowed at the HDS Picker's Market: alcohol or cigarettes, drug paraphernalia, piercing, or anything illegal or questionable.

No electricity is provided

Each vendor space is approximately 10' x 10'. Tents are suggested, but not required. Tents must fit in the allotted space. Corner weights are required.

You must provide any equipment you need, eg. tables, chairs, or tents.

No alcohol, drugs, or smoking is allowed at the market.

Pets must be kept on a leash and all "accidents" disposed of immediately.

No parking on the north side of Front Street in front of downtown merchants.

Do not park on Depot lot or block the Depot drive. Additional parking will be provided.

You are required to remove all merchandise at the end of the sale.

No refunds will be given.

HDS nor the City of Sikeston is liable for damages incurred to vehicles or goods from poorly secured tents, umbrellas, or vendor actions.

Transfer of a space between individuals must be approved by HDS 24 hours prior to the market.

Spaces will be assigned by HDS on a first come, first serve basis.
